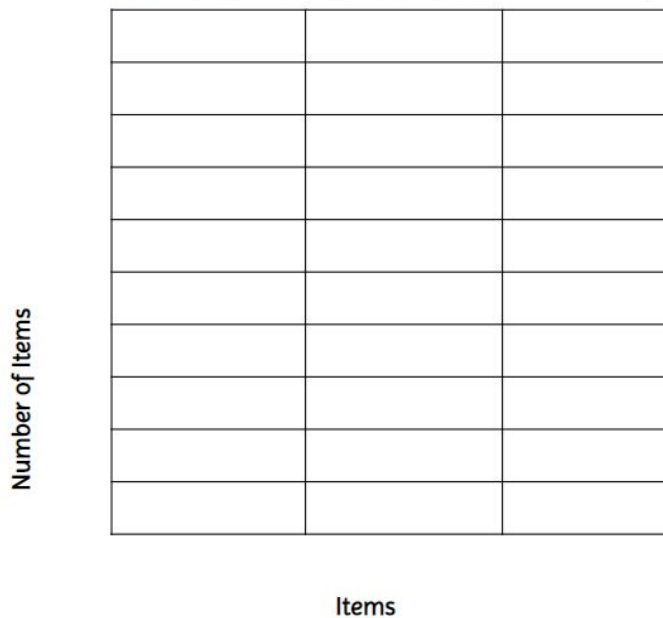

Do you think you'd find the same items on a sunny day or in a different season? Why?



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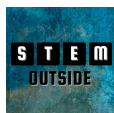
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
